

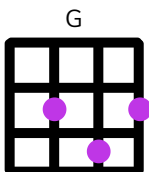
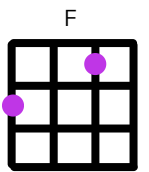
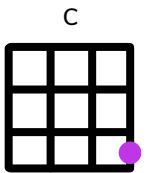
Amazing Grace - John Newton

3 Chords: C, F, G, C7*, G7*

- First note to sing: G
- Easy strumming suggestion: Down strum on every underlined syllable.
- The chord C7 is optional. If you prefer, play a C.
- You can choose to play G7 instead of G if you prefer.

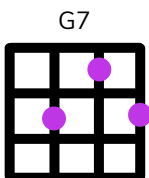
VERSE 1:

I once was lost, but now am found; was blind, but now I see.



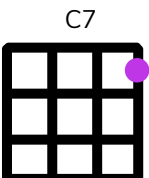
VERSE 2:
